Note :-

i) The above dates (Para 1 (g) to (m)) are to be strictly adhered to. No extension of date will be granted.

ii) 'Deficiencies' in various categories may occur if there is a shortage of qualified candidates to fill in the available vacancies in those categories. After the allotment of unutilized seats, through internal transfers, in a stepwise manner, as enumerated in Para 11 of Sainik Schools Society Letter No. 4(1)/SSS/2016 dated 13th October 2020, further deficiencies, if any, in all categories may be filled up by candidates in Waiting List of other Sainik Schools, as per a combined merit list prepared by the deficient Sainik School, of applicants (eligible candidates of other Sainik Schools) who meet all the mandatory conditions.

2. The Entrance Examination, AISSEE-2021, will be conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA), on behalf of the Sainik Schools Society. NTA will undertake the newspaper advertisements, online registration and application (through its website www.aissee.nta.nic.in, conduct of the examination, evaluation and generation of results. An Information Bulletin will be posted on the NTA website (www.nta.ac.in) and the same is required to be on all the Sainik Schools websites. Previous year's question papers may also be viewed on the NTA website. The contact numbers of the NTA Helpdesk (open from 1000 to 17000 on all weekdays) are 8287471852, 8178359845, 9650173668, 9599676953 and 8882356803 and the email id of NTA for any correspondence is aissee@nta.ac.in.

3. All India Entrance Examination (AISSEE)- 2021-2022 for both classes VI & IX will be held on 10-01-2021 (Sunday). AISSEE-2021 will be a paper pencil test on OMR answer sheets. Candidates are required to attempt Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ). There is no negative mark for a wrong response. Admission will be strictly based on merit, medical fitness and submission of requisite documents/ certificates (including originals) as proof.

4. Eligibility for **Admission to Class VI:**

(a) A candidate should be between 10 and 12 years as on 31 March 2021 for admission to Class VI, i.e. he/she should have been born between 01 April 2009 and 31 March 2011 (both days inclusive) for admission to the academic year 2021-22.

(b) Admission for Girls is open for Class VI. Age criteria is same as boys. Candidates may be advised to check the availability of seats for girls from **Appendix VI of Information Bulletin** carefully.

5. **Eligibility for Admission to Class IX:**

(a) A candidate should be between 13 and 15 years as on 31 March 2021, for admission to Class IX, i.e. he/ she should have been born between 01 April 2006 and 31 March 2008 (both days inclusive). Admission to Class IX is not open for girls.

(b) He/ she should have passed Class VIII exam from a recognized school at the time of admission.

8. Medium of Examination for Class VI examinations will be English, Hindi and one of the official languages of the States where Sainik Schools are located. The question papers for Class VI will be in the chosen medium. However question papers for Class IX will only be in English.

9. The minimum qualifying marks for candidates of OBC-NCL, Defence and General category will be 25% in each subject with 40% in aggregate. However, no minimum marks are prescribed for candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe category. They will be admitted on the basis of inter-se merit at the Entrance Examination within their respective categories, subject to medical fitness and verification of requisite documents. In case an SC/ST/ OBC-NCL candidate comes in the general merit on his/ her own, he/ she would be admitted against general seat and will not be adjusted against the reserved share of SC/ST/ OBC-NCL seats.

10. **Inter-se-merit of candidates in case of a tie.** In case the total marks scored by two or more candidates in AISSEE 2021 are equal (i.e. there is a tie with regard to overall marks), the marks for individual subjects/ factors will be considered in the following order of priority:-

11. The Examination Fee is to be paid online while filling the application. The rates (excluding taxes as applicable) are as follows:-

12. School-wise tentative list of vacancies for the academic session 2021-22 for Classes VI and IX is published in the Information Bulletin. The vacancies reflected therein are based on the current strength of Class XII and existing deficiencies in other classes (against the total authorised strength of the school). The number of vacancies is subject to withdrawal of cadets on various grounds. The transfer out of cadets will determine the consequent number of admissions. However there will not be any change if the present status is 'Nil' in any of the category/ class. Similarly, the authorised strength of the school should not be exceeded. Category-Wise Distribution Chart, circulated vide Sainik Schools Society Letter No. 4(1)/SSS/2016 dated 13th October 2020 is to be used as a reference guide for allocation of seats.

13. Although NTA is also informing prospective candidates about the online application and the entrance examination through a public notice in national and state newspapers, Sainik Schools are also required to accord wide publicity about the examination through Akashwani, Doordarshan and by means of posters, handouts etc (in Hindi, English and regional language) and by any other means as per the local conditions. A copy of the NTA Public Notice is enclosed with this letter. State Directors/ Directorates of Publicity may be contacted for having press handouts issued. The reservations of seats for children belonging to SC/ST/ OBC-NCL category and the availability of scholarships from various sources may be explained properly. Each school will be responsible for making its own publicity arrangements indicating that the school does not patronise any coaching institutes/ agents and the admissions will be strictly in accordance with the merit of candidates in the Entrance Examination, medical fitness and submission of requisite documents/ certificates (including originals) as proof.

14. Candidates domiciled in Telangana will be considered to be part of the Home State of Andhra Pradesh. Similarly, candidates domiciled in Ladakh will be considered to be part of the Home Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir. Candidates belonging to other States and Union Territories where Sainik School is not yet established will appear under Other States/ UT quota in the relevant category at whichever Sainik School they opt for.

15. **Reservations**

(a) 67% of the seats in each Sainik School are reserved for candidates from the State/ UT in which the Sainik School is located and 33% of the seats are reserved for candidates from Other States/ UT. For the purpose of seat allocation, two lists are prepared - 'List A' (for candidates from Home State/ UT) and 'List B' (for candidates from Other States/ UT). The qualified candidates from the Home State/ UT and other than Home State/ UT are arranged in order of merit as per their category under List-A and List-B respectively. The candidates will be allotted seats as per the percentage of reservation specified in Para (b) and (c) below.

(b) Firstly, within each list (List 'A' and List 'B', i.e under both Home State/ UT and Other States/ UT), 15% of the total seats are reserved for Scheduled Castes; 7.5% seats for Scheduled Tribes and 27% seats for Other Backward Classes- Non Creamy Layer(OBC-NCL). Reservation for OBC-NCL category will be considered as per the central list of Other Backward Classes available on National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC), Government of India website www.ncbc.nic.in, as on the first day of the month in which the process of Online Admission Form commences.

(c) Out of the balance seats, 25% seats within each list (List 'A' and List 'B', i.e. under both Home State/ UT and Other States/ UT), are reserved for children of service personnel including ex-servicemen (Defence category). The remaining seats are reserved for children belonging to General category under both Home State/ UT (List 'A') and Other States/ UT (List 'B').

(d) In "Other States/ UT" quota, seats will be allotted in each category as per merit, subject to a maximum limit of 25% of vacancies in the category for any State or Union Territory. For example, if there are 10 seats in Other States/UT General Category, not more than 3 seats will be allotted to any one State, i.e. 25% of 10 or 2.5 rounded off to 3.

(e) In Class VI of each Sainik School, 10% of the total vacancies or 10 seats, whichever is more, are reserved for girls.

16. It should be noted that the medical examination in respect of the candidates is to be completed within the prescribed time frame, so that the candidates and guardians are not inconvenienced. The school will not be responsible for any delay in receiving medical examination notice/letters by the cadets, including postal delay. In this regard, the Initial Call List of candidates for Medical Exam, the final Merit List and all other results and notifications are required to be uploaded on the school website. Any request for change of date in the medical examination may be considered on a case to case basis, subject to genuine reasons and meeting the stipulation of completing medical examination within the scheduled time frame.

17. Your attention is invited to the contents of Sainik Schools Society Letter No. 4(1)/SSS/2016 dated 13th October 2020. The directions given therein are to be strictly complied with. Principals and Staff of Sainik Schools need to be familiar with the contents of Information Bulletin on the NTA website.

18. Staff children seeking admission to Classes VI and IX as day scholars will also appear in the Entrance Examination. Their admission will be carried out subject to their qualifying in the Entrance Examination and in accordance with the existing Rules and Regulations on the subject.

NTA will be conducting the **AISSEE-2021** for admission to Class VI and Class IX in 33 Sainik Schools across the country, for the academic year 2021-22. Sainik Schools are English medium residential schools affiliated to CBSE and managed by Sainik Schools Society (Ministry of Defence). They prepare cadets to join the National Defence Academy, Indian Naval Academy and other training academies (officers).
