### ACADEMICS

It is pertinent to mention that intake pattern of this school is such that boys from even remote parts of Bihar with no English language background are able to join this school. Chiseling such raw material into a finished product which is capable of facing and succeeding in all walks of life is our motto being the newly established school. We however are sure that academic result will be still better in the forthcoming Examinations. The first batch of our school will appear for CBSE Board Examination. I wish they will produce a grand result to honour this school and their Parents.

73 cadets have participated in Central Zone Inter Sainik Schools Sports and Co-curricular Championship 2007 - 08 held at Sainik School Tilaiya (Jharkhand) from 08 to 11 Aug 2007. The overall team position within the Zone is IIIrd.

## **EDUCATIONAL TOURS AND EXCURSION**

The importance of educational tours and excursions including organizational capabilities & leadership qualities needs no emphasis. With this aim trips to Jiradai, the birth place of our first President, Late Dr. Rajendra Prasad and Air Force Station Gorakhpur were conducted under the arrangements of the School administration.

## **ADVENTURE TRAINING**

A total of 104 cadets (from Classes VIII & IX) and 03 teachers were nominated for Adventure Course at Himalayan Mountaineering Institute, Darjeeling for a period of 07 days w.e.f 14 to 20 May 2007.

Adventure Training Camp at Shri Aurubindo Education Society, Nainital has been organised from 13 to 20 Oct 07 as per Training Calendar of Sainik Schools' Society. A total of 25 cadets (from Class IX) and 01 teacher have already left to attend the Camp.

The school has a well established computer laboratory including internet facility. We have our own website and facilities of e-mail for the cadets.
