- 1. Which ruler first established his or her capital at Delhi?
- 2. What was the language of administration under the Delhi Sultans?
- 3. From which country did Ibn Battuta travel to India?
- 4. According to the "circle of justice", why was it important for military commanders to keep the interests of the peasantry in mind?
- 5. In 1236 Sultan Htutmish's daughter, Raziyya, became Sultan. She was removed from the throne in 1240.
- 6. Minhaj-i-Siraj recognized that she was more able and qualified than all her brothers. But he was not comfortable at having a queen as ruler. Nor were the nobles happy at her attempts to rule independently.
- 7. Rudramadevi was queen of Kakatiya dynasty of Warangal from 1262 to 1289. Rudramadevi changed her name on her inscriptions and pretended she was a man.
- 8. Queen Didda, ruled in Kashmir between 980-1003. The name comes from "didi" or "elder sister".
